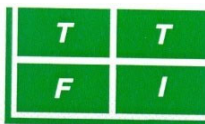

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Only registered players of the TTFI for the year 2026 can participate in the Championships;
2. All the matches will be played according to the rules and regulations for the Regional Championship as adopted by TTFI;
3. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-19) events are open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2008;
4. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-17 Junior) events are open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2010;
5. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-15 Sub-Junior) events are open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2012;
6. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-13 Cadet) events are open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2014;
7. The Youth Boys & Girls (U-11) events are open only to those players who are born on or after 1.1.2016;
8. For evidence of age, players should bring their Original Date of Birth Certificate issued by the Municipal Corporation/School so that it can be verified, if and when required;
9. All players will have to make their arrangements for Boarding/Lodging;
10. The decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final in all matters concerned with the Championships;
11. The Tentative Schedule will be as follows:

Day 2	07 Oct	U 11 B/G up to QF, U 13 Main Draw, U 15 B/G Qualifications
Day 3	08 Oct	U 11/13 B/G up to Final, U 15 B/G Main Draw, U 17 B/G Qualifications
Day 4	09 Oct	U 15 B/G Main Draw R/16, U 17/19 Qualifications
Day 5	10 Oct	U 15 B/G up to Final, U 17 up to R/32, MS/WS, U 19 Qualifications
Day 6	11 Oct	U 17 B/G up to Final, U 19 Main Draw R/32, MS/WS Main Draw R/256/128
Day 7	12 Oct	U 19 Main Draw up to QF, MS/WS up to R/16
Day 8	13 Oct	U 19. MS/WS up to Final

(Please note that this is only a tentative schedule and the CM has the final authority to change it based on the final entries in consultation with TTFI/OC)

12. Entries close at Noon on 21 September for Institutions and at Noon on 23 September for the State Associations. However, the Secretary General of TTFI has the discretion to accept any entry under special circumstances after the deadline closes.
13. DRAW FOR FIRST STAGE OF U 11/13 Boys and Girls AT 11:00 Hrs. on 5th October at Venue followed by each other.
14. FIRST STAGE DRAW FOR THE REMAINING EVENTS ON 6th October at Venue.
15. **Normal and Extra Entries:**
Men/Women – 5 Entries with normal entry fee and additional with extra entry fees;
For Institutions – 2 Entries with normal entry fee and additional with extra entry fees;
Other events- 4 Entries with normal entry fee and additional with extra entry fees;

Institutions PSPB/Railways are eligible to give 5 entries with normal entry fee, and additional entries will be with extra entry fees
.
Players in Men/Women who are ranked within the top 8 in India, according to the latest ranking, need to pay only the Normal entry fees.

TTFI can accept wildcard entries (Maximum 32) in each event, and they will be treated as additional entries with the applicable event fees.
16. Equipment: **Stag Roma Tables and Stag Global 3 Star 40+ balls.**
17. All official communication and the draw shall be displayed at the venue on August 15, and that shall be the only official communication in all respects. This championship will be regarded as a ranking tournament, and points shall be awarded, as specified in the TTFI guidelines.
18. **Online Entries: Entries must be submitted online via the event page on our website, ttfi.org. Each State Association/Institution has already been provided with a Username and Password, which may be used to log in to the Online Entry System. No entries will be accepted by mail or any other method of communication. No entries will be accepted after the deadline.**
19. For any clarification regarding online entries, States/Institutions may contact the Federation office at: domesticevent@ttfi.org
20. All players should register with the TTFI. We will not accept entries from unregistered players. Players already registered with the TTFI should pay a registration fee of Rs. 500/- for 2026. This may be paid with the entry fees for the first tournament they play in the calendar year. All Youth category (U 19/ U 17/ U 15/ U 13/ U 11) players should submit their Date of Birth Certificates and Aadhar copy keep the originals for verification, if and when required.
21. Transfers of players from one state to another are allowed only before the start of the season. Once registered with a particular state, players will not be eligible for any transfer during the season.

22. The entry fee will be as follows.

First five entries in Men, Women:	:	Rs. 1000/- each
First four entries in U-19, U 17	:	Rs. 900/- each
First four entries in U-15, U-13	:	Rs. 800/- each
First four entries in U-11	;	Rs. 700/- each

23. State Associations may submit additional entries per Clause 15 above.
The entry fee for additional entries will be as follows:

Seniors/U19/U17	Rs. 3700/- each
U 15/U13	Rs 2700/- each
U 11	Rs 1700/- each

23. **Payment of Entry Fees:** The entry fee must be paid online. The system will generate an invoice, and the State Associations/Institutions are required to make the payment. Entries will not be reflected in the system unless the entry fees are paid. Therefore, all state associations must remit the entry fees before the deadline. Otherwise, their entries will not be registered for the Championships. NO entry fee will be accepted by the TTFI office or into any account other than the online payment system. Entry fees will not be accepted at the venue. The entry fees must be paid on or before 10th August through the online system; otherwise, entries will not be accepted.

Mandatory Payment of Entry Fee

All players, State Associations, coaches, managers, and other representatives are requested to ensure that the prescribed entry fee is paid through the designated online payment system on or before the notified deadline. An entry will be considered complete and valid only after the successful receipt of the prescribed fee within the stipulated time.

Please note that entries for which the entry fee has not been received by the deadline will not appear in the online entry system and cannot be accepted for the tournament. As the draw and tournament logistics are finalized immediately after the closing date, it may not be possible to accommodate late payments, payments at the venue, or requests for manual inclusion after the deadline.

Accordingly, participants are advised to verify that both their entry and payment have been successfully completed within the prescribed time.

TTFI appreciates the cooperation of all players and State Associations in adhering to the entry timelines, which help ensure the smooth and fair conduct of the tournament. However, TTFI reserves the right to make exceptions in extreme cases.

25. SPORT CANCELLATION/CHANGE IN NOMINATIONS

Cancellation of participation is allowed until noon on 5th October. After this deadline, the penalty policy will take effect, and no changes will be accepted to players' entries; affected players will have 20 points deducted from the ranking. If cancellation cannot be processed through the online system for any reason, please inform the Competition Manager before the deadline. However, entry fees for all entries must be paid to the organizers via the online system by the dates of closure of entries for Institutions (21 September) and States (23 September).

27. INFORMATION FOR PLAYERS

By entering the event, players agree to abide by all TTFI rules and regulations of the Organizing Committee. All participating associations and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the TTFI and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet, webcasting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage. Participants release all rights, including those held by their agents or sponsors, in all matters relating to television and webcasting coverage, video and motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. A participant's refusal may result in suspension or dismissal from the competition.

28. THE PLAYING SYSTEM & SEEDING RULES FOR NATIONAL RANKING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025:

Seeding Rules:

MEN & WOMEN: Players ranked in the top 50 of the ITTF Singles World Ranking list as of the date of the first draw will be seeded first, and the remaining seeding will be based on the latest National Ranking as of that date. (This is in accordance with the decision of the AGM dated 19th July 2024)

Other Events: The latest National Ranking will be followed.

Nominated players from the same Association/Institution will be separated only in the first stage of Group events, not in the subsequent knockout rounds.

The entry ranked 1 shall be placed at the top of the first half of the draw, and the entry ranked 2 at the bottom of the second half, but all other seeded entries shall be drawn among specified places in the draw, as follows:

- The entries ranked 3 and 4 shall be drawn between the bottom of the first half of the draw and the top of the second half;
- The entries ranked 5-8 shall be drawn among the bottom places of the odd-numbered

- **quarters of the draw and the top places of the even-numbered quarters;**
- **The entries ranked 9-16 shall be drawn among the bottom places of the odd-numbered eighths of the draw and the top places of the even-numbered eighths;**
- **The entries ranked 17-32 shall be drawn among the bottom places of the odd-numbered sixteenths of the draw and the top places of the even-numbered sixteenths.**
- **The rest of the entries will be drawn at random among the vacant positions in the Draw.**

Direct to the Main Draw:

Men's Singles/Women's Singles: Top 16 Ranked Players

All other events (except YS Under-11): Top 8 Ranked players

The remaining players will be divided into groups of 3 or 4. In all the events, only one player qualifies from each group to the Main Draw. The Referee will conduct the draw under the supervision of the Competition Manager/Technical Committee.

All matches will be played best of 5 games of 11 points each except the Semi-Finals and Finals of the Men's and Women's Singles and finals of U 19 Boys and Girls Singles, which will be played best of 7 games.

29. PLAYERS' CLOTHING

By entering the Championships, all players undertake to abide by the ITTF's player clothing rules already in force (ITTF regulation 3.2.2 of the ITTF Statutes).

Opposing players shall wear T-shirts of sufficiently different colors to be easily distinguished by spectators. When the opposing players have a similar T-shirt and there is no consensus among them about who would change, the umpire will make the decision shall by lot.

30. PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES

Athletes are expected to attend the following promotional activities:

- Opening Ceremony
- Media interviews
- Award Ceremonies (in full tracksuit and sports shoes)

Failure to participate in promotional activities may result in loss of prize money and medals or both.
